Respect Life Sunday.....Respect Life Month October



Today is Respect Life Sunday, and the opening of Respect Life Month in the Catholic-Christian community. Our Catholic-Christian teaching on the Respect for Life is consistent and clear. We believe in the sacredness of all human life from the moment of conception until natural death. We are called by God and the Church to be entirely

Pro-Life, from womb to tomb, meaning we are to stand foursquare against abortion, euthanasia, murder, suicide, the death penalty, and any other violations against the natural order of human life. God is the Creator of Life, and God is the only rightful taker of Life. In recent times two of the concrete ways Catholic-Christians in California have borne witness to our belief in the sacredness of human life has been in our efforts to defeat the Assisted Suicide bill in the Legislature, and in the currently ongoing, 40 Days For Life Prayer Vigil, Sept. 26-Nov. 4, being held at abortion facilities. Peaceful protest and legislative lobbying are some of the ways we can help achieve the goal of affirming the dignity and reverence we should show for all human life as Catholic-Christian disciples of Jesus.
