Let's Talk: Heart to Heart

What is the Ministry of the Divine Mercy Chaplet about? This Ministry helps us to receive God's Grace of Mercy, Consolation, and Salvation for those who already died, ability to forgive, to enhance our openness for the God's Grace that is lavished upon us every day. Those in this Ministry are praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy daily as Jesus asked His Church through the decision of the Holy See acknowledging the apparition of Jesus to St. Faustina.

Praying the Chaplet, are offering the life of Jesus for the Salvation of the whole world according to the words of this prayer passed to us from our Savior. What makes the prayer work is our love, and always God's Mercy. Jesus promised His Grace if we offer this prayer for the Salvation of the world, if we offer Him "for the atonement for our sins and for the whole world". Jesus offered this sacrifice in His Life and now He wants us to be very active contributors of His Body and Blood and help others to contribute. The Divine Promise is firm: if you pray this Chaplet, then God's Mercy will satisfy the thirst for Heaven, and will help us in our needs on Earth.

In this Ministry we have thirty parishioners who are arranged in a prayer line. Almost every day the prayer line receives from a coordinator, the names of people in their spiritual or physical need of healing. These needs are passed to the coordinator from any parishioner. The Chaplet is prayed for them anytime in a private way. In this Ministry an additional Chaplet is prayed daily at 3:00 pm, at the time of Jesus' death. Every Thursday there is the opportunity to come together to pray the Chaplet at the time of Adoration at 5:00 pm. The Ministry also offers prayer with those who are dying, assisting them at the final days. Please consider yourself to help this Ministry in prayer line!
